Farming in Northern California since the 1870's, our family's roots run deep. In 1968, our grandfather took a chance and planted Twenty Acres of wine grapes. As generations have passed and our vineyard acreage has grown, so has our commitment to sustainably producing premium, handcrafted wines.

But our family will never forget our humble start, and that it all began with Twenty Acres.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Our sustainably grown Cabernet Sauvignon is a reflection of the special place our family has called home for generations. During the growing season, warm days are tempered by cool, evening delta breezes, allowing us to achieve beautiful complexity and balance. The addition of 23% Petite Sirah, a nod to our original Twenty Acres, provides additional complexity, depth of flavor, and a more luxurious mouthfeel.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of cherry and blackcurrant lead with a ripe, fruit-forward entry. Hints of new leather, mocha, sagebrush and baking spices add complexity thanks to the contribution from the American oak barrels used in the aging process. The addition of Petite Sirah provides a velvety texture and length to the finish.

Aged in a combination of 59% American oak and 41% French oak
