Dijon clones 777, 667, 115, 114, Pommard and Wädenswil

FERMENTATION

Fruit was destemmed (10% Whole Cluster) and cold soaked for nearly 7 days, fermented in the 1.5 ton bins and stainless-steel tanks for 14-21 days, then pressed and racked to barrel.

AGING

11 months in 80% Stainless Steel, 20% in 225L French barriques with 5% being new French oak

COOPERAGE

Tight grain, medium toast barrels from a variety of coopers

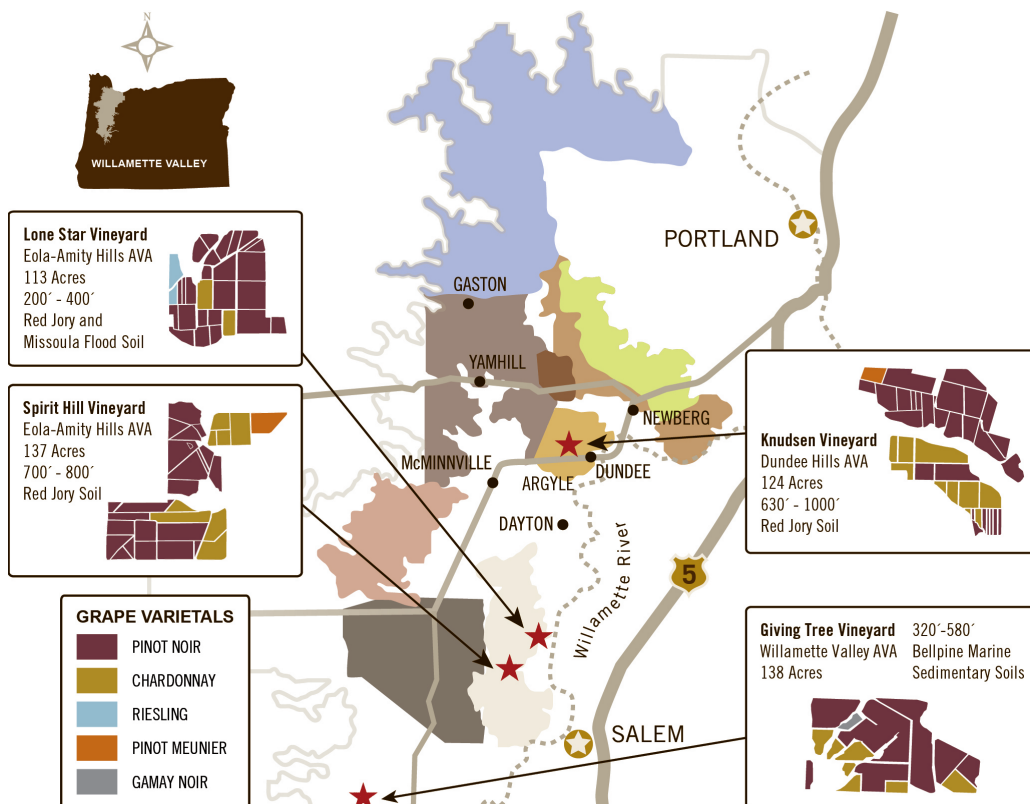

- **VINEYARD:** Argyle farms four estate vineyards making up nearly 500 acres in the Willamette Valley, with the majority in the Eola-Amity Hills and Dundee Hills nested AVAs.
- **REGENERATIVE VITICULTURE:** Regenerative farming encourages the symbiotic relationship between the earth and the vine in tandem with the development of habitats for native flora and fauna. Our result from sustainable and responsible practices includes healthier soils, energetic vineyards and fruit.
