# 2021 SAN SIMEON PASO ROBLES CABERNET SAUVIGNON



## Region/Vintage Notes

Our 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon was farmed from three of our estate vineyards in El Pomar AVA of Paso Robles. Due to the breezes flowing through the Templeton Gap, this coastal appellation experiences warm days and cool evenings. The 2021 season saw pre-season rainfall and a warm summer producing smaller berries and lower fruit volumes. Each of our vineyards feature steep hillsides with rocky or marine-derived soils. Vines reach deep into the soil for water and nutrients resulting in grapes with highly concentrated flavors. Heatwaves throughout the summer season slowed berry development. Small berries lend to a high skin-to-juice ratio.

## Winemaker/Tasting Notes

Following the fermentation and pressing process, our 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon was aged in a selection of 60% new French and American Oak barrels and 40% neutral. Highlighted by deep dark hues and robust flavors of plum, black cherry and blackberries. The nose is greeted with aromas of baking spice, nutmeg, and tobacco. With soft, long-lasting leathery tannins, the mid palate is rich and spicy, balancing the wine with a long, round smooth finish.

# Sustainability

Sustainability is a top priority at San Simeon. Our Paso Robles Vineyards are certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA). At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional use.
