VINTAGE NOTES

WINERY INFORMATION: Paraje Altamira, with its high altitude and cool microclimate, has become synonymous with world-class wines. The soils of Paraje Altamira are very diverse, with patches of sandy, rocky and silty soils dispersed throughout the vineyard.

LABEL NOTES: ZaHa means “Heart” in Mendoza's native Huarpe language. With deep, sprawling roots, the vines in the Toko vineyard literally extract the “Blood of the Earth” from deep within the rocky limestone sub soil.

WINEMAKING: Whole cluster, oxidative press with no SO2 added. Cold decantation to remove all oxidates phenols and then the clean juice is racked to a concrete egg for natural yeast fermentation. Lees moved periodically to maintain wine cloudy and slightly reduced, thereby avoiding SO2 additions. No malolactic fermentation and no oak aging

COLOR: Lemon color with golden hints

TASTING NOTES: Expresses aromas of white flower and herbal notes accompanied by a citric profile and green apple. Fresh on the palate, with a medium body and a long finish due to a pronounced acidity and hints of minerality.
